# NEW FOR 2023-24 YEAR

## NEW SCHOOL FEE SCHEDULE

KCI's SCC approved a new single fee structure for this year. This fee per student covers basic student supplies (see reverse side for details) and co-curricular activities & supplies for students held throughout the year.

#### NEW SCHOOL DAY HOURS:

School Day hours will be **8:55 am to 3:19 pm** with a 40-minute lunch hour (**12:10 to 12:50**). Buses will pick up students at **3:19 pm**.

## NEW EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS:

Please watch for information coming to you regarding early dismissal days. We are just finishing up some housekeeping and will have this finalized soon.

#### NEW QUAD SEMESTER SYSTEM FOR SENIOR CLASSES:

Our senior classes will be using a Quad Semester system. All other grades, Grade 5 through 9 will continue with the full-year and 2-semester scheduling. All grades will be scheduled with five class periods per day on a new five-day schedule - Monday through Friday. (Previously a six-day schedule).

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

## SCHOOL OPENING & REGISTRATION:

The first day of classes is September 5<sup>th</sup>. The school will be open starting August 30th for pre-registration or such can be done online at <u>gssd.ca</u>. New Students registering at KCI are asked to bring their most recent report card and <u>required identification</u> (Birth Certificate &/or Health Card). Students registering on September 1st will not start the day of registration to allow us to make the proper preparations.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Phys. Ed. is compulsory for all students with exceptions made for medical reasons. Medical certificates <u>must</u> be handed in at the beginning of the year. <u>An appropriate change of clothing is required for Phys. Ed.</u> Some students wear shorts and T-shirts, others wear sweat suits – both are acceptable. All students also require running shoes for Physical Education classes as well as for general wear around the school. **IMPORTANT**: If purchasing new runners, which are to be used in our gyms, please purchase shoes with light, no-scuff soles. Runners with black rubber soles are not allowed in our gym classes as they mark the floors.

#### TEAMS / SPORTS / ACTIVITIES

Students on school teams and/or traveling clubs will be assessed a fee to offset the costs associated with the activity. These costs include equipment, uniforms, and transportation. Set costs are as follows & all other fees will be communicated to you at the beginning of the activity / event / season. Remember you can pay your fees using School Cash.
