1. CALL TO ORDER:

Shelly called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

a. SCHOOL FEES

A DECISION ITEM providing student fees background information and guiding principals for student fees were provided for council's discussion. No fees have been collected for band or school fees for the 2022-2023 school year. Karie suggests annual school fee all in one. A planned review of the school supply list as a lot is not necessary.

- i. -provide basic supplies to students this will come out of the annual fee
- ii. -transportation costs are high fee can help with this
- iii. -40.00 annual fee. 20 to supplies, and 20 to transportation

THAT the KCI student fees be set as follows for 2023-24 year.

FEE	DESCRIPTION	DUE	AMOUNT
Student	All students attending KCI shall pay a student fee	Annually	\$40.00
Fee	annually. Half of this fee will cover necessary student school supplies. The remainder will go to school transportation costs.

Replacement Lock Fee	Students are encouraged to purchase locks from the school. Locks are warranted for breakage if the student is enrolled at KCI.	Upon Purchase	\$10.00
Instrument Rental	Students wishing to rent an instrument for band class may enter into a rental agreement with KCI.	One time per year	\$50.00
Extra- Curricular Activities Fees	Students on school teams and/or traveling clubs will be assessed a fee to offset the costs associated with the activity. These costs include equipment, uniforms, and transportation.	Fees must be paid in full to participate in activities	Varied - depends on activity.

b. EARLY DISMISSAL

DECISION ITEM: Principal Karie provided reasoning for having early dismissals once a

month for students. This would require students to be dismissed from classes on a Thursday or Friday at 1:30pm. Having an early dismissal day would provide extra learning time for the teachers. Teachers need more self-care & learning opportunities.

Motion: April moved. Andrea seconded.

THAT a survey be sent to parents of KCI students to choose Thursday or Friday for an early dismissal day once per month AND FURTHER THAT KCI ensures parents understand the purpose of this early dismissal in that this is for teacher extra learning opportunities and not for just more holiday time.

c. PLAYGROUND

Principal Karie shared an unfavorable status report of our school's playground. The slide getting removed cutting children is a hazard. The basketball net is leaning. There is a need for:

- a cement pad for seniors.
- walkways made for wheelchair.
- possible garden.

We have an opportunity to make the playground better for the kids. It was asked that the SCC add the playground to KCI's SCC Fundraising Activities plan so that we can begin to ask for grants and donations.
