NEW SCHOOL FEE SCHEDULE

KCI School Community Council approved the fee schedule as follows for the 2024-25 school year.

Grade(s)	Fee	When	Amount
5 – 12	Student Fees: covers basic student supplies (see reverse side for details) and co-curricular activities & supplies for students held throughout the year.	Annually	\$40
10-12	Elective Class Fees: used to offset the costs required for specific class supplies, materials required to meet class curriculum outcomes.	Fees will be charged at the start of Quad in which it is offered.	\$25-40

Locks	All KCI student lockers are required to be locked. Students may bring a lock from home. If needed a lock will be provided by KCI.		No Charge
Instrument Rental	Students wishing to rent an instrument for band class may enter into a rental agreement with KCI.	Annually	\$50.00
Extra-Curricular Activities Fees	Students on school teams and/or traveling clubs will be assessed a fee to offset the costs associated with the activity. EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS:

KCI School Community Council agreed with the administration that the Early Dismissal Days were valuable opportunities for professional development for the teachers and support staff. We will be continuing these again this year. Once the dates are finalized, we will let families know.

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SCHOOL OPENING & REGISTRATION:

KCI pre-registration will begin Tuesday, August 27, 2024. It is important to note that new students registering at KCI are **required** to present identification (**Birth Certificate &/or Health Card**) and will **not** start the day of registration. Our student registration process requires a meeting to be scheduled with our Student Services team for assessment before your student starts school. This allows for a healthy transition for your student.

NEW QUAD SEMESTER SYSTEM FOR SENIOR CLASSES:

Our senior classes will be using the Quad Semester system again this year. Grades 5-9 will continue with the 3-reporting system.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Phys. Ed. is compulsory for all students with exceptions made for medical reasons. Medical certificates **must** be handed in at the beginning of the year. **An appropriate change of clothing is required for Phys. Ed.** Some students wear shorts and T-shirts, others wear sweatsuits – both are acceptable. All students also require running shoes for Physical Education classes and general wear around the school. **IMPORTANT:** If purchasing new runners, which are to be used in our gyms, please purchase shoes with light, no-scuff soles. Runners with black rubber soles are not allowed in our gym classes as they mark the floors.
