

EXPLORING INNOVATION: Grade 9 Science Fair at KCI

For the Grade 9 Science Fair, students choose a project based on their personal interests. Their presentations will be judged by a panel of teacher judges. The judging criteria will include

Scientific Method:


- Did they develop a question that could be answered through experimentation?
- Did they develop a test to validate the hypothesis?
- Is there a clear and thorough process for data observations and collections?
- Did they derive conclusions from appropriately organized data, and did the conclusions relate back to the hypothesis

Presentation:

- Is it neat, well-organized, and visually appealing?
- Does it show all aspects of the scientific method?
- Are the students able to explain and answer questions related to the experiment?
- Was the investigated question original, or did it use an original approach or technique?

The winners will receive prizes.

The fair is open to everyone in the public, and we encourage parents, family members, and community members to come and support our young scientists and creators. It's a great chance to see the amazing projects our students have been working on and to celebrate their hard work and achievements. We look forward to seeing you there!




A HEART FELT THANK YOU for a Successful Family Engagement Event
